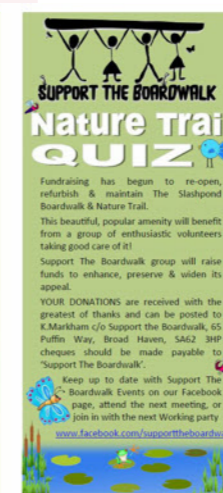
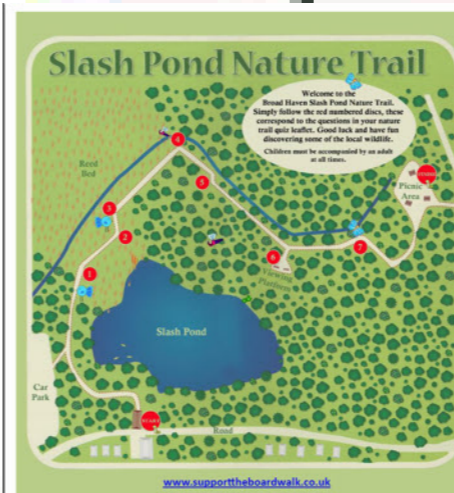
There is no charge for parking but we ask that you consider making a kind **DONATION** in this box to **Support The Boardwalk**

To enjoy our efforts so far, please turn left out of the car park and the Walk Starts 30mtrs along!

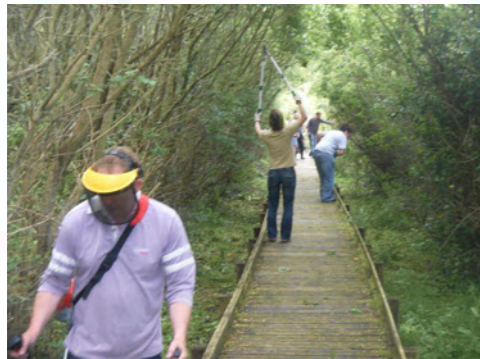

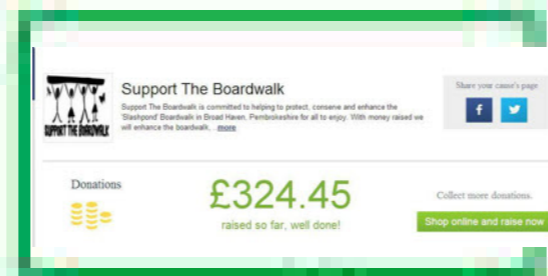

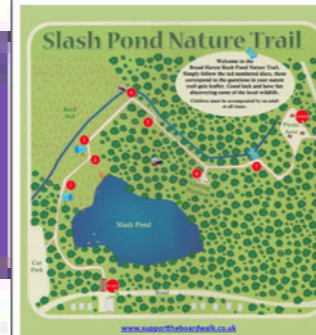
