## Imminent Start - Boardwalk Extension Project

The Enhancing Pembrokeshire funding is all confirmed and our project spending profile has been lodged with funders, PCC.

Local contractor Bob, from Down To Earth Landscaping, will be laying the steel soon. It's been ordered and is on its way once it's been shaped and galvanised. Once the ground work starts there will be some disruption to the route, so please bear with us. The target completion date is March 1st 2019 but this will be subject to weather conditions.

We're putting our energy into biodiversity this year and hope to develop a plan to see this move forward. We know there's already a lot of different plants & animals in the area around the pond and boardwalk but there's also more than can be done to make it the healthiest place possible for nature (and us!).

We met for low-key food and chat in January, and in March (Sat 23rd) we will be clearing up the pond around the dipping deck and other parts around the boardwalk and meadow.

## Insurance ...

... is up to date: STB has renewed its volunteer insurance with Keep Wales Tidy for a further 12 months. This covers all volunteers registered for activities and using their own tools, when out & about maintaining the picnic area & boardwalk habitat.

The Slashpond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our wonderful Blue Flag beach. A sheltered 235 metre non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, ¼ mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.
