Change of event

By the time you read this notice, our team of volunteers with the help of Dan Wynn (the National Park Ranger) will have cleared away much of the growth from around the dipping deck, allowing it to be used by all throughout 2019. This was going to happen March 23rd, but it came to our attention that the local amphibian population had already got that date in the diary for spawning! Well, we wouldn't want to get in the way of that. We will also have made a new wild flower meadow near the picnic tables, so look out for life emerging there in the near future...



The Slashpond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our wonderful Blue Flag beach. A sheltered 235 metre non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, 1/4 mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately 1/2 mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

Date for your diary – Triathlon!

We're proud to be helping with the Mike's Bikes Pembrokeshire Coast Triathlon for another year. The date this time is Saturday 8th June, so get that in your diaries. The bonus this year is that the race doesn't kick off until 11.30am, so all those early birds that help the competitors and visitors park can have a bit of a lie-in! We're planning to use the event to raise funds specifically to improve the accessibility of the bird watching screen, making it easier for users of wheelchairs and mobility scooters to enjoy our fabulous piece of equipment. Other improvements

This year we'll be working towards improving the accessibility of the boardwalk, enabling those with limited mobility to enjoy every part of the boardwalk trail. We're also developing the signage of the boardwalk area, hoping to enhance visitors' experience as well as make clear to them the variety of elements of the boardwalk (picnic area, birdwatching screen, dipping deck, wild flower meadow, etc.)
