Did you know that between us we:

The Slash Pond Boardwalk is an alternative

attraction to our wonderful Seaside Award beach (the



national standard for the best beaches across the UK). At more than 350 metres, the boardwalk is a sheltered, non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with our Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately 1/2 mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

- Keep an eye on incoming mail messages to the group and share out the actions.
- Fund-raise to provide enhancements to the area whether by having coffee mornings, selling own-designed/produced note-lets, applying to community funds or collecting donations made to the donation box sited on the boardwalk.
- Keep the community 'in the loop' via our <u>Havens Diary</u> entries & this monthly newsletter.
- Risk assess the boardwalk, record our findings and again action any to-dos discovered.
- Flag our activities via Social Media posts.
- Connect with the village school to encourage our younger visitors to be engaged with this amazing habitat on their doorstep.

- Stock our friendly retail and refreshment outlets with a quiz leaflet to give visitors access to a trail, taking in pond dipping and bird watching opportunities.
- Support the Pembrokeshire Triathlon with volunteer course & car-parking stewards.
- Liaise with <u>Pembrokeshire Coast National Park & Keep Wales Tidy</u> to tap into their knowledge to carry out our actions sympathetically to the area.
- Liaise with <u>Havens Community Council</u> (HCC) who are the lease-holders of the Slash pond and surrounding land.

We are a volunteer group and encourage all locals to give attention to any small issues spotted while taking in the habitat - we really appreciate those who lend a hand whether by lopping off a bramble that's poking through, getting in the way, or disposing of some litter The boardwalk is enjoyed by the whole community, and it really it helps when we can all pitch in.
