beaches across the UK). At more than 350 metres, the boardwalk is a sheltered, non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

The Slash Pond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, 1/4 mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with our Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

As we move towards winter in these challenging times it's a good time to remind you of the amenities of the Boardwalk and Slashpond area with beautiful walks around the boardwalk, benches to sit and look out over the pond, the dipping deck and of course the bird-watching platform! Recent changes include brand new information signs around the entire Boardwalk and the path to the bird watching platform has been concreted to allow easier access for wheelchairs and buggies. We hope you take the opportunity to visit the boardwalk and enjoy its tranquillity and being so close to nature. We do remind you to remain vigilant of other users of the Boardwalk and maintain social distancing, even if it means you going backwards to one of the viewing areas or wider portions of the path.

"Just to let you know a rare bird has been seen and heard at the Slash Pond, a **Hume's Warbler**. It would be the second record for Pembrokeshire. It was heard on Friday, and seen briefly and heard again today [last Sunday]. You have done a fabulous job with the boardwalk and interpretation, well done! Some nice birds around the area today included Firecrest, Water Rail and Black Redstart."
