Never fear Support the Boardwalk is here ...

... with ideas to help you educate the children whilst they are learning from home!

- Let's get outdoors!
- What's the phrase? There's no such thing as bad weather, only unsuitable clothing!
- And all these ideas are FREE!

The Wildlife Trust have an amazing web page full of *activity ideas*! There are Spotter Sheets, Colouring Sheets, Activity Guides, Masks to Make and even a Fact Sheet on how to turn natural objects into musical instruments!

Another simple idea is a **Bird Count Log.** Take a slow walk around the boardwalk and note the names of the birds that you see. Then go home and draw the birds all on one large sheet of paper and colour the pictures in. Take the Bird-Log out with you

on your next walk and put a tick next to each bird, each time you see one along your walk!

Or let Nature inspire your **Creative Writing** skills! Take a walk and note things that you experience – use your senses. What did you SEE, HEAR, SMELL & TOUCH? You can do TASTE too if you enjoy a well earned biscuit at the end of your walk! Then write a story or poem about what you experienced!

The Slash Pond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our

wonderful Seaside Award beach (the national standard for the best



beaches across the UK). At more than 350 metres, the boardwalk is a sheltered, non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, 1/4 mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with our Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.
