Fire Shock!

What was turning out to be a quiet and restful August for STB volunteers, as visitors and residents enjoyed the quiet and idyllic seclusion offered by the Boardwalk and nature reserve, was shattered when the fire service were called out to deal with a fire in the picnic area. We were shocked and disappointed to find that both bug hotels, built by local children, had been completely demolished, used for firewood and a huge black scar was left where the grass and earth had been scorched!



The Slashpond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our wonderful Blue Flag beach. A sheltered 235 metre non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, ¼ mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

Shock turned into an incredible community spirit which led to a group of volunteers meeting the very next afternoon to clean up the mess and even re-build one of the bug hotels. Special thanks go to the kind person who called the fire service, to the fire service for coming out late on a Saturday night to put out the fire, to all those who offered help, donated palettes and materials to rebuild, to the volunteers who gave up their time to clean up and repair and all the kids that helped.
