Making the most of the habitat

Pond-Dipping

The Boardwalk gang, using a carefully placed pallet to balance on the water[!], have cleared silt from the area in front of the dipping deck, to allow a better depth of water, clear of weeds. The new sign on the dipping deck provides clear instructions on how to ensure a safe pond-dipping session and is complimented by a link on our website www.supporttheboardwalk.co.uk to the PCNPA Pond-dipping leaflet, so that dippers can discover the names of all the creatures they find!

The Slashpond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our wonderful Blue Flag beach. A sheltered 235 metre non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, ¼ mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

Boardwalk volunteers are keen to encourage the next generation of custodians for the boardwalk. Working with the 'Eco Group' from Broad Haven school, our partners; PCNPA Rangers Hayley & Dan and Keep Wales Tidy's Ranger Mari, have helped us engage the children in sessions at the Slashpond habitat. They have taken part in making bug boxes, meadow management and pond -dipping. During the sessions the children learned about how to look after the environment, not drop litter, etc.

They are now fully fledged JUNIOR BOARDWALK RANGERS!

New bird watching platform - Update

To attract & satisfy the 'twitchers' that visit the Slashpond habitat, Support The Boardwalk are planning their next project - to create a Bird-watch platform. The discreet platform will extend out to the Slashpond to a 'boundary.' Panels will allow visitors to get 'up close' to the birdlife. The volunteers are seeking the expert's advice on this project and will love to hear from any. To allow a good visual expanse, the project will involve reaping some of the reed growth which is encroaching onto the water. Its hoped that this will also create a 'mud platform' that will encourage ducks, geese & swans to land. We are also researching the possibility of working with swan rescue to provide a safe environment for swans that are ready to be released back into the wild!
