The Slash Pond Boardwalk is an alternative attraction to our wonderful Seaside Award beach (the national standard for the best beaches across the UK). At



more than 350 metres, the boardwalk is a sheltered, non-slip, paw friendly decked walkway surrounding a serene pond in a habitat that supports a wildflower meadow, a picnic area, willow dens, bug houses and bat & bird nesting boxes.

Parking at Trafalgar Terrace car park (along the seafront, turn left at the Galleon Inn, ¼ mile on the left. Parking is free with a donation box at the entrance to help local community groups). Walk out of the car park, turn left, the walk entrance is 30 metres on the left. Sat Nav directions use SA62 3JU. Bring along a small net and enjoy the 'Dipping Deck' or test yourself with our Nature Trail Quiz. The area offers a circular route of approximately ½ mile which is accessible to motobility scooters, wheelchairs and pushchairs.

A Full 'Makeover' Is Imminent ...

Their aesthetics match the recently re-vamped nature trail quiz leaflets (remember copies of these are available from many of the retailers, bars & restaurants around the Havens), so our image makeover is nearly complete.

Thanks to funds awarded for a community project by Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water, the signs are 'fresh' off the printing presses ... as can be seen from this 'teaser' picture. Our volunteer crew will now be making plans to organise labour and materials to mount and install them on site.
